Remember very few entries are perfect!! Don't be put off entering whatever you can.

Vegetables & Fruit Section:

Onions should be left unskinned; tops trimmed & folded. Leeks – cleaned, not cut, with tops plaited or bent over. Shallots – tops tied with garden twine & displayed on saucer of sand.

Tomatoes - leave calvx attached.

Root vegetables should be washed with a sponge, not a brush which could damage the skin.

Fruit should be presented in a fresh condition, with bloom intact, not polished.

Stalks should be intact & left on fruit.

Take care that your entry complies with the Schedule.

Kitchen Section:

Jams & jellies – varieties should be labelled, jars to have see through tops & contents covered with a wax disc. Chutney – covered with a screw top lid & wax disc. Wines/spirits – to be labelled, preferably in clear bottles, tops to be easily removable & no foil caps. Eggs – same colour & size, displayed uncooked on a

plate.

Flowers:

Should be fresh & free from insects, symmetrical in size & quality, stems left as long as possible.

Double check the Schedule and make sure you follow the brief supplied.

SHOW RULES & PROCEDURES

- A. All entries MUST have been produced by the exhibitor; on ground owned or rented by them for their own cultivation. No person can enter the same class more than once.
- B. Each entry must have been produced or made within the last 12 months leading up to the Show.
- C. Entrants shall be current, past or temporary residents of Charlton Musgrove or connected through family, village clubs or Church.
- Entry at Hall between 8.30 and 10.15 on Show Day.
 The Hall will be cleared for judging by 10.45 NO
 LATE ENTRIES CAN BE ACCEPTED.
- E. Each entry must be accompanied by a card 5cm x 8cm (2" x 3") with Class Number on **FRONT** and **NAME ON REVERSE**. The Organising Team reserve the right to refuse an entry.
- F. Clearly indicate on reverse of Show card if the item CANNOT BE SOLD. We will take reasonable care but cannot be responsible for removal, damage or loss of exhibits.
- G. The Judges' decision is final.
- H. Any protest must be made in writing to the Secretary by 2.45 on Show Day.
- No exhibit may be removed before 3.00pm the Sale will be held at 3.15pm.
- J. Points are awarded: 1st = 3 pts; 2nd = 2 pts; Commended = 1 pt; Best in Section = 3 pts. In the event of a tie, the Trophy will be awarded to person with most entries in the Section.
- K. Family Cup: Team is a maximum of 4 people from same family. Large families can enter more than 1 team. Team should be named, and members listed and handed to Secretary at time of entry. Points are awarded: 1st = 3 pts; 2nd = 2 pts; Commended = 1 pt;
- L. Even if you are in a Team, your entry is still included for individual points.


